Take I-270 W via the ramp to Dayton. Take exit 17B on the left to merge onto OH-161 W/US-33 W. Take the exit toward Avery Muirfield Dr/Dublin. Turn left at Avery Rd. Turn right at Shier Rings Rd. Take the 2nd right onto Eiterman Rd. Washington Township Fire Training Center will be on the right.

From the North:

Take Columbus Pike/US-23 S. Merge onto I-270 W via the ramp to Indianapolis. Take exit 17B to merge onto OH-161 W/US-33 W toward Marysville. Take the exit toward Avery Muirfield Dr/Dublin. Turn left at Avery Rd. Turn right at Shier Rings Rd. Take the 2nd right onto Eiterman Rd. Washington Township Fire Training Center will be on the right.

From the West:

Take I-70 E. Take exit 93B to merge onto I-270 N toward Cleveland. Take exit 17B on the left to merge onto OH-161 W/US-33 W. Take the exit toward Avery Muirfield Dr/Dublin. Turn left at Avery Rd.
